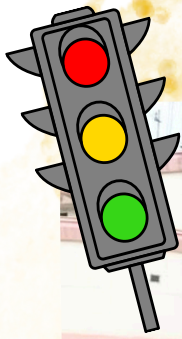


National Penguin Day

THRIVE: Integration into the Teaching-Learning Process

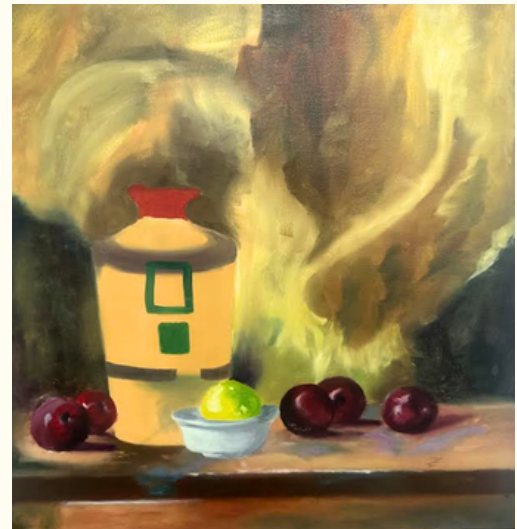
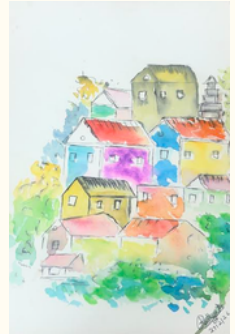
